At its Annual Conference Session in June, the Upper New York Annual Conference approved the creation of a \$1 million scholarship endowment fund for Africa University (AU) to create eight scholarships each year in perpetuity to continue to plant *Seeds of Hope* and nurture the next generation of leaders in Africa.

Over the next three years, the conference's AU Scholarship Task Force will be spreading the good news about Methodist-founded Africa University: its mission, programs and students.

This campaign will offer a means to learn, grow and give in the name of Jesus Christ for AU, and create God's grace for both we who plant the seeds and those who will reap the harvest.

This Lenten season, look for the focus *Seeds of Hope*, with worship aides including litanies and recommended music. Then at an immersion event on March 25, 2012, AU speakers will be featured in all 12 districts and many of our local churches.

Other events to watch for:

A Vacation Bible School program highlighting Jesus' calls to us, and how these calls are lived out at AU and here where we live.

In 2013, a Unity Walk/Run and Bike Ride event

How you can plant *Seeds of Hope*:

- Participate in at least one program (VBS, youth, church-wide Bible study, UMW, etc.) during the three-year campaign period, which continues until June 2013.
- Host an Africa University speaker during that period
- During Lent, ask every member to contribute \$1 a day to the AU Scholarship Endowment Fund.
