They will be performing for the UN as a part of an AIDS Awareness program later in their tour.

HUMBLE is an acronym for: **H**elping **U**gandan **M**wana **B**y **L**oving **E**xample. ("Mwana" is a Luganda word for Child). The school seeks to devise a sustainable way to provide for the future of families and children whose lives have been adversely affected by poverty, civil wars, famine, HIV/AIDS and other diseases. The Humble School offers opportunities for education and hope to orphans and vulnerable children in the five countries of East Africa: Uganda, Kenya, Rwanda, Burundi, and Sudan.
